Pitner Driving School, Inc.

Applicants must be within 15 and 19 years of age.

- 1. Classes consist of a two week classroom session (30 hours) followed by 6 hours of driving instruction.** Driving time will be scheduled during one of the classroom sessions and will come **after** the two weeks of classroom. Pitner Driving School, Inc. does not substitute backseat observation nor computer simulation for actual driving time with a state certified instructor.
- 2. Tuition is \$380. Half (\$190) must be paid with the application. The balance is due the first day of class.** Checks are to be made payable to **Pitner Driving School, Inc.** There will be no refunds after the first day of class. If a student withdraws before the first day of class, a fee of 10% (\$38) will be retained by Pitner Driving School to cover the cost of processing the application.
- 3. PLEASE NOTE:**
For students 15 years and 6 months of age (or older), who have successfully completed the Driver’s Ed course and hold a Tennessee Learner’s Permit, the *Tennessee state road test (driving portion of the driver’s license test) may now be administered by Pitner Driving School. Students desiring to take the Pitner administered state road test are required to take an additional 1 hour of driving time instruction at the additional cost of \$60. After the 6 hours of driving instruction, the instructor will notify the student whether they possess the skills necessary to successfully pass the road test. The parent may then schedule an appointment with Pitner Driving School for the road test. **Passing the road test is not guaranteed. Be advised that the Department of Traffic Safety (DOTS) may randomly select applicants with road waivers to retest at the patrol station.**

*PLEASE NOTE THAT THE TENNESSEE STATE ROAD TEST MAY BE TAKEN BY APPOINTMENT AT **NO CHARGE** AT THE TENNESSEE HIGHWAY PATROL STATION.
- 4. If a student resides in Tennessee and has no learner’s permit, then Pitner Driving School will administer the written test for the permit at no additional charge. The student must score an 80% or better to qualify for the written waiver. The student is still required to show proper identification and to take the vision test at a highway patrol station. The DOTS may randomly select applicants with written waivers to retest at the patrol station.**
- 5. Upon successful completion of the course, students will be issued a Driver Education Certificate for a possible insurance discount along with a Grade Evaluation Sheet so that parents will better understand the student’s driving strengths and weaknesses.**
